



Dear Patients:

We at Cassopolis Dental take your health very seriously. That is why we continue to monitor the situation regarding the COVID-19 virus. In order to ensure the safety of our patients and dental team members, we continue to closely adhere to the CDC's guidelines regarding sterilization and sanitizing. Additionally, we are taking extra precautions by:

1. Asking patients who have recently traveled internationally or are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19; including a fever over 100 degrees, cough, or chest pains to refrain from entering the building and calling to reschedule their appointments.
2. Removing all complimentary food and drink items from the waiting area. These items will still be provided to patients upon request.
3. Asking all adult patients to arrive to their scheduled appointments alone; unless accompanied by a caregiver or other person providing necessary assistance.
4. We are asking children to be accompanied by only 1 parent.
5. Asking all elderly patients considered medically compromised to adhere to CDC issued travel guidelines.

The U.S. Center for Disease Control recommends the following measures to reduce the risk of contracting COVID-19:

- Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, throw the tissue in the trash and wash your hands.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after using the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing.

For the safety and well-being of our patients and dental team we ask that if you or a family member are ill, please stay home and contact our office to reschedule your appointment. We are happy to help you find another convenient time.
